Officer Of the Day Duty (OOD) The role of Officer Of the Day is very important in running the club's sailing programme. Safe sailing can only be maintained with good safety cover. To achieve this, we require all adult sailing members to contribute their share of OOD duties. This may include helping to run the race or, to provide safety cover, for which we provide tuition. The Committee tries to put OODs together in such a way that an inexperienced person is on duty with experienced people. If you are unable to fulfil the OOD duty on your allotted day, it is important that you swap. It is your responsibility to do this & to update the Dutyman sailing programme

We will be monitoring OOD attendances to ensure that everyone contributes equally.

Documents relating to the following policies can either be found in the club, on the website & on the club house computer.

1 Safety Policy: Calshot Sailing Club operates a safety policy to provide & promote safe practices for all areas of club activity. Anyone who goes afloat is entirely responsible for his or her own decision to do so. They should take into account their own capabilities, the prevailing conditions & the boat's seaworthiness. In the case of members under the age of 16 years old, the child's Parent or Guardian has sole responsibility for their child(s) decisions

2 Safety Cover: Safety cover is only provided during the hours of club racing, training & other planned & supervised activities. Safety boats provide escort & assistance to club boats. Their primary concern is safety of club members, this will not be compromised in order to retrieve boats or property.

3 Data Protection: Personal details will only be used for club purposes & will not be disclosed to anyone outside of the club without your permission. Email addresses provided by you will be added to a newsletter mailing list, which you may opt out of at any time.

4 Child Protection Policy: Calshot Sailing Club operates a Child Protection Policy in which the child's welfare is paramount.

5 Boat & Trolley Identification All equipment including boats, launch trolleys and boat covers left on club premises must be marked with the last name and initial of the boat owner ensuring that it may be easily identified. Any items not meeting this requirement risks being identified as belonging to a non-member resulting in disposal.

6 Photographs: From time to time the committee may take photographs of club events showing activities members are participating in. These photographs may be used for publicity on the web and via other media. Should you not wish your image to be shown please notify the committee in writing or by e mail.

Monthly Payment by Direct Debit

We continue to offer the facility to pay your annual fees by monthly Direct Debit (DD).

We can only do this by working through a third party. We have selected "GoCardless" as they are recommended by the RYA.

GoCardless charge an administration fee of £1 per month for this service. Therefore the monthly membership charge is: your annual fee divided by 12, plus £1.

If you wish to participate in this scheme, please complete your membership form in the normal way and let me know by e mail that you'd like to pay by monthly Direct Debit **before the end of February**. We will then set this up for you.

Likewise, for those who participated in the scheme last year, your final payment will be taken in February. If you wish to continue to pay by DD please let me know when you submit your membership renewal and I will set up a new plan for you.
